Audioconference to Highlight Strategies for Disconnected Youth

YOU are cordially invited to register for a free audioconference on re-engaging disconnected youth to take place **Thursday, February 23, 2006, at 2:30 p.m.** (Eastern Time).

The audioconference, titled “**Strategies that Work for Our Disconnected Youth,**” will offer a preview of lessons learned by the YEF Institute through close examination of collaborations in eight cities, with an emphasis on how city leaders can provide leadership and spur action by others. The YEF Institute will issue a publication on the topic later this spring.

How the Audioconference Works

This audioconference is free, but it is available only to a limited number of participants. Therefore, advance registration is required by close of business Tuesday, February 21, 2006. A separate registration is needed for each phone line that will be used in listening to the call.

Some registrants gather a group of people together around a speaker phone and use the call as a springboard for a brainstorming meeting or as a training session.

One day prior to the event, each audioconference registrant will receive an e-mail or fax message that will provide a toll-free, dial-in number to call in order to join the audioconference.
