WHEREAS, voting is a constitutionally protected right; and,

WHEREAS, participation in free and fair elections is fundamental to democracy; and,

WHEREAS, city leaders play a supportive role in creating safe, fair, and accessible options to allow every eligible voter to participate in elections; and,
