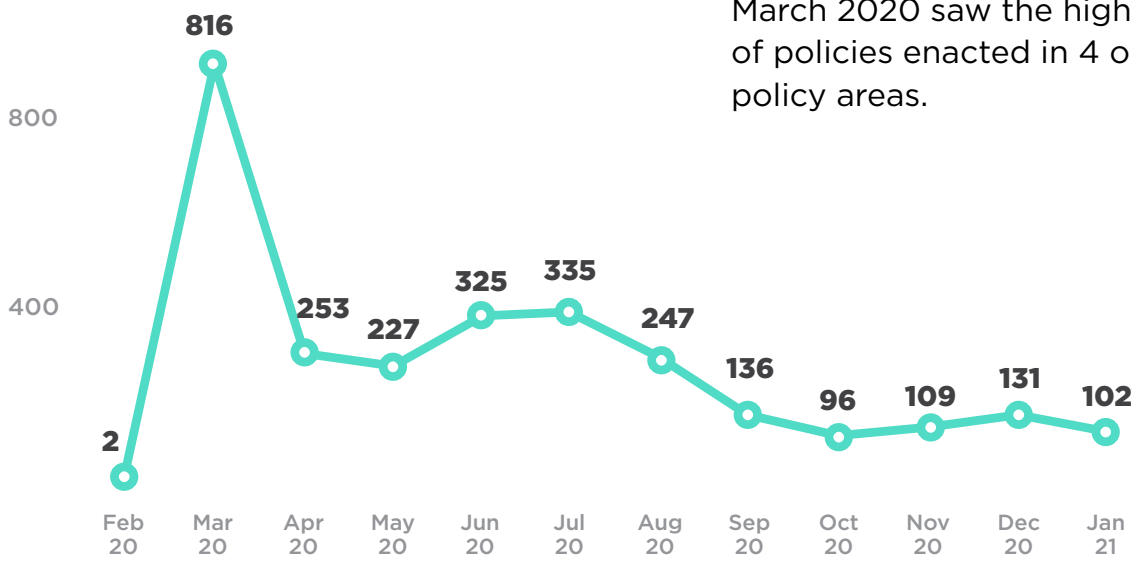

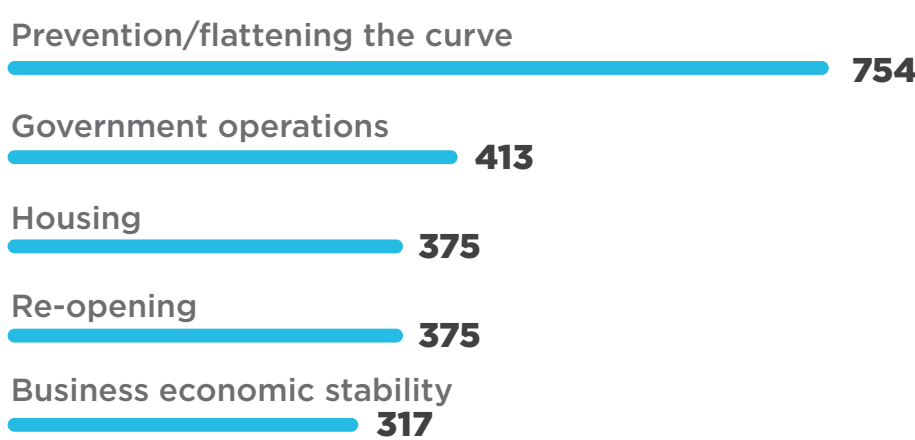


Cities acted swiftly

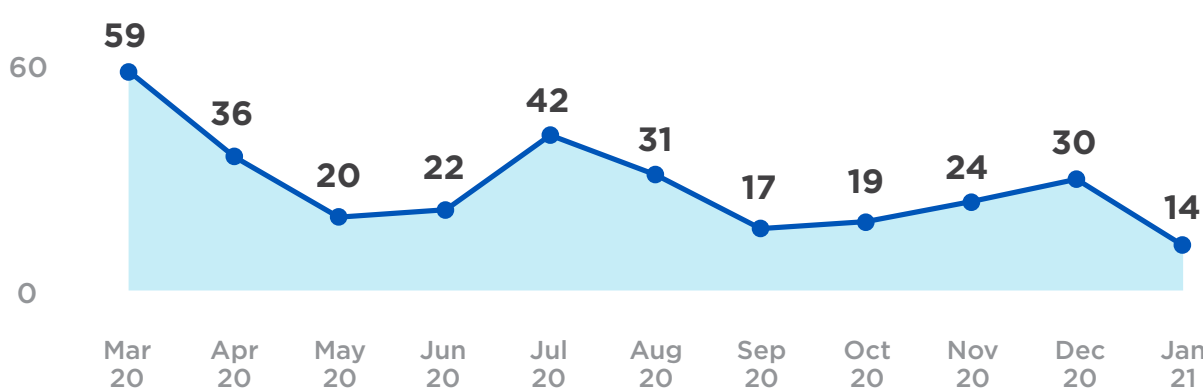

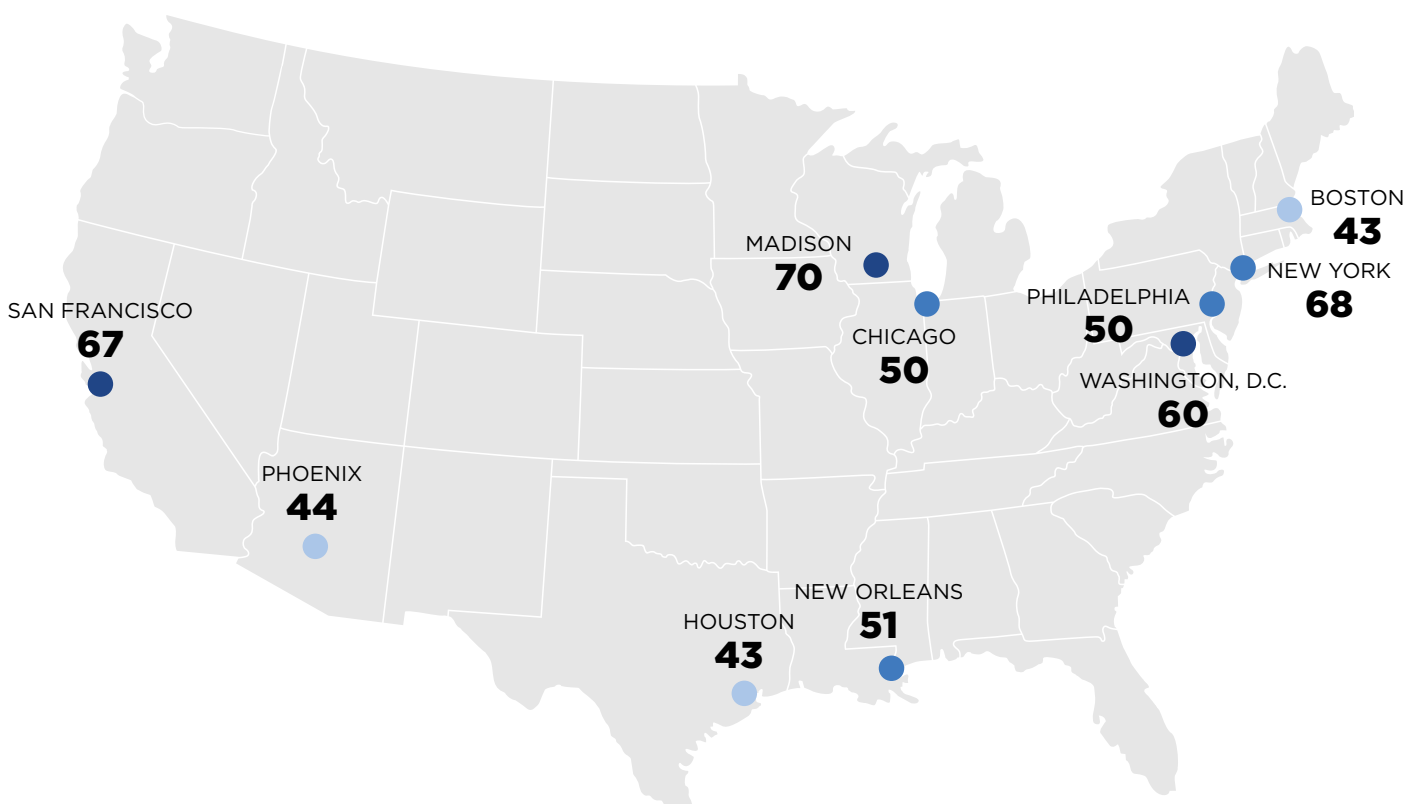
