- TRANSPORTATION: Empower local governments as a true partner in fixing transportation using the Surface Transportation Block Grant, safety, and technology grant programs that cities and towns of all sizes can access.
- WATER: Provide financing, funding and flexibility to meet the nation's growing water infrastructure needs and address the impacts of climate change.
- **BROADBAND**: Invest in **urban and rural broadband** infrastructure to close the digital divide in communities and unleash local leadership by removing obstacles to municipal, public-private, and co-op provided broadband.
- WORKFORCE: Invest in skills training to ensure that local workers can participate in building, rebuilding and maintaining our critical American infrastructure.
- Preserve ARPA funding that is meant to provide immediate relief from COVID-19 disruption.
