

## Ready To Rebuild August Recess Site Visit Guide

**Goal:** Site visits are a critical tactic to building and strengthening relationships with your Members of Congress. As Congress continues to negotiate toward a bipartisan infrastructure proposal, we encourage local leaders to <u>reinforce</u> the ask for a strong infrastructure package that invests with cities in the infrastructure you need.

Who Should Participate: Elected official, Public Works Director/City Planner, employees involved in specified project, local media outlet, local business owner and/or constituents impacted by chosen project.

What Information Should You Share: We encourage you to <u>review the comprehensive list of local</u> <u>investment priorities</u> that NLC is advocating for. However, it is critical to not just showcase the priority infrastructure project in your community, but also highlight the neighborhood and the impact the project will have on residents and businesses.

- We need an infrastructure package that streamlines investment directly to the local level and eliminates inefficient bureaucratic processes and puts every dollar to use quickly and efficiently. Share timelines and project plans to emphasize this efficiency.
- How can investments leverage local and regional efforts to build or complete a surface transportation project that will improve the community's mobility?
- How will additional funding be used to address any drinking water, wastewater and stormwater infrastructure needs impacted by climate change?
- How will financing for broadband infrastructure, adoption and affordability reach your communities? What are the current barriers to adoption and affordability?
- How does your municipality invest in your local talent pipeline in building, rebuilding and maintaining your priority infrastructure projects?

Broadband- Provide new financing and funding for broadband infrastructure, adoption, and affordability that directly reaches communities of all sizes and remove state legal barriers to local broadband decision-making

4.) Workforce- Invest in skills training, including short-term occupational training and on-the-job training, that will support a local talent pipeline in building, rebuilding, and maintaining our critical American infrastructure.

We hope that this visit will show you how an investment in local infrastructure is an investment in our country. In tandem with the National League of Cities, we encourage you to support a comprehensive infrastructure package that will create many different opportunities for growth in our community and communities across the country.
